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AP Art History

Grades: 10-12

One semester – ½ fine Arts Credit

Prerequisite: None

This course is a study of Western and Non-western painting, sculpture, and architecture for the Prehistoric to Gothic periods. Artworks will be presented in the historical, social and political contexts in which they were created. The fundamental skills necessary to analyze art will be developed. Both art history courses are necessary to prepare students to take the Advanced Placement examination and best if taken sequentially. This course can be taken for three college credit hours through UMSL. A weighted grade is given.

Goals:

.....to acquire working knowledge of artistic terminology.

.....recognize the periods of art that we study through art works and architecture.

Grades will be based on class participation and completion of assignments.
