
Looking Back at Pierremont's History

Pierremont Elementary School first opened its doors in 1967 when a farmhouse, barn and green pastures were just beyond the kindergarten fences. Expansion came rapidly as the farm was sold and the pastures quickly filled with new homes. In 1990-1991, Pierremont reached its highest enrollment with 734 students.
