VIII. Principal Report – Dr. Roberts

- b. MAP Testing 4/18-5/3 for 3rd, 4th and 5th Grades.
 - i. Dates for each grade will be sent home.
 - ii. Please avoid appointments or your child missing school during this time.
- c. Field Day 5/16
 - i. Hot dog roast and games will need volunteers.
 - ii. Lunch provided for students and staff.
- d. Playground improvement updates:
 - i. Three companies were contacted, received options from two of them.
 - ii. Half of the swings from the front playground had to be removed due to being too close to the concrete walls. Parkway is working on fixing the issue.
 - iii. Some building funds may be available to put towards playground improvement (~\$10,000).
 - iv. Dr. Roberts would like to form a committee to review options and make a plan.
 - v. Option from company #1:

- 1. Phase plan to replace the entire front playground at the top of the hill.
- 2. Phase 1: \$26,480; Phase 2: \$24,000, new swings \$6,800, shade structures/tables \$6,700.
- 3. This option would take years of fundraising to accomplish.
- 4. Mrs. Boice raised concern of parking. If we replace the playground in the same location, there would not be the option to take some of that space for more parking. She suggested moving the playground to part of the front field if full replacement option is chosen.
- vi. Option from Company #2:
 - 1. Keep current playground equipment.
 - 2. Add shade structures to front top playground.
 - 3. Pick and choose some free standing play structures to add to current equipment.
 - 4. This option could likely be done with the funds we have from PTO and Building Fund.
- vii. Discussed option of looking for grants to help cover playground improvement costs.
- viii. Dr. Roberts to discuss with other principals how they have handled playground improvement.
