Activity:

1. **Mad Lib story:** Have a room helper get words for the blanks of the mad lib story **Mummy wrap:** split class into groups of 3 or 4 and one child in that group gets wrapped by the other 2 or 3 kids (Tamara is bringing a tub to be set outside the classrooms for the empty paper tube rolls)

Split kids into 2 groups and one half does:

- 3. **Glow necklace toss onto a witch's hat.** (Glow necklaces are a party favor to keep) While the other half:
- 4. **Relay with mini pumpkins** form two lines of kids, balance their mini pumpkin on their head for the relay and repeat until the other half of the room is done and then switch activities (mini pumpkins are a party favor to keep)

Craft:

- 1. Fall Tree: On 8x12 white construction paper, children draw their hand down to their elbow. This is the tree and branches. They color in the tree and branches. Using their pencils, they wrap a 1 inch square of colored tissue paper around the end, rub a glue stick over it and stick it on the branches.
 - a. Materials: white construction paper, tissue paper, crayons or markers

Activity:

- 5. Read the Mad Lib story
- 6. Dance to Halloween music on teachers' smartboard
- 7. **Read a story** (Heather will bring Room on the Broom)
- 8. **Eye Spy** if time allows or as a take home

Mummy Wrap:

Split class into groups of 3 or 4 and one child in each group gets wrapped by the other 2 or 3 kids. Each child gets a roll of paper.



Glow necklace toss onto a witch's hat.

One half of the glass will be doing this while the other half will be doing the mini pumpkin relay. Have each child take a turn throwing a glow necklace three times or so onto a witch's hat. They get to keep the glow necklace.




Relay with mini pumpkins

This activity is done with one half of the classroom while the other half is doing the witch's hat toss, then the groups will switch and do the other activity. For the mini pumpkin relay, form two lines of kids, they balance their mini pumpkin on their head for the relay and repeat until the other half of the room is done.



Fall Tree Craft
