

Second Grade Party:

ITY - Mad Libs

Description

- One parent volunteer will do a Mad Libs with the kids while the other volunteers set up

ACTIVITY - Mad Scientist Chemistry Project

description - While the students are still seated at their desks from the Mad Libs activity, parent volunteers will pass out supplies for the craft. The students will work at their desks to make slime by mixing two ingredients in a disposable cup. Once complete, the students can transfer their finished product into take-home sized bags.

materials needed

- borax
- clear elmer's glue (or colored if available)
- popsicle sticks for stirring (one for each student)
- disposable cups for mixing (one for each student)
- small ziplock bags for taking home the slime (one for each student)

ACTIVITY - Snow Cone Balloon Pass Relay (make sure no one in the class has a latex allergy)

description - The class will be divided into two teams and form two lines facing each other. Each student will be given a snow cone cup, and the first student will have an orange balloon. When the parent in charge of this game instructs the students to begin, the first student from each line will pass the balloon to the next student using their snow cone cup. The balloon will continue down the line until the balloon reaches the end. The last student

will then reverse the direction, sending the balloon back up to the first student in line.

materials needed

- snow cone cups for each student
- two balloons per class

ACTIVITY - Monster Mash Ping Pong Ball Dance

description- Parents will secure an empty tissue box to the each students' lower back using masking tape, and five ping pong balls will be placed inside the empty box. When all the students are ready to go, the song "Monster Mash" will be played, and the kids will be instructed to dance with vigor so that the ping pong balls come out of the tissue box! If all the balls have been bounced out of the box and the song is still playing, the kids are welcome to replace the balls and continue to dance or jump!

materials needed

- one empty tissue box per student
- masking tape (or duct tape)
- 5 ping pong balls per student

ACTIVITY - Mummy Makers

description - Each student will be given a roll of toilet paper, and the class will divide into groups of 2-3. One student will be the "mummy" and the other student(s) will decorate the mummy using the toilet paper. This was a big hit last year! Once the mummy's are complete, the

decorators can look at their handiwork, along with their classmates' work. Since this activity is fairly quick, the student who was the decorator can be given the option of being the "mummy" next if they'd like. Students who would prefer just to decorate are more than welcome to continue to do so. This activity is not a race, but rather a chance to have fun wrapping up their classmates and show some creativity with their wrapping strategy and style.

materials needed

- toilet paper

Activity - Pumpkin Punch for Prizes

description - At the end of the party, the students will receive a small selection of fall-themed prizes. I've attached a photo of the pumpkin punch board for your reference :). The room mom's will complete this board prior to the party, and at the end of the party, the students simply come up to the board one by one, pick a cup, punch through the tissue paper and grab their prizes. All the cups will contain the same set of prizes.

materials needed (to be completed prior to party)

- trifold display board

- paint

- cups (one per student)

- tissue paper

- small prizes
