Parkway Northeast Middle School PTO - Quick Overview

★ Who Can Be an Officer?

- Must be a PTO member.
- Must have a child at Parkway Northeast Middle School or be a staff member.
- Can hold only one board position at a time.
- Can serve up to two consecutive terms, with a possible one-year extension if no replacement is found.

PTO Board Positions

- President
- Vice-President
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- Note: Any position can be co-chaired.
- Additional board members include the Immediate Past President and the School Principal.

How Are Officers Chosen?

- A nominating committee, appointed by the President, selects one nominee per position.
- Elections are held at the final meeting.
- Nominations from the floor are allowed if the nominee agrees.
- If a position becomes vacant, a special election is held following the same process.

What Do the Officers Do?

- President/Co-Presidents
 - Lead all meetings.
 - o Coordinate activities and committees.

 - Work closely with the Principal.Appoint special committees as needed.
 - o Notify members of meetings at least five days in advance.
 - Share meeting minutes with the incoming president.

Vice-Presidents

Serve as liaisons between grade-level teams and the PTO.

Secretary

- o Record and distribute meeting minutes.
- o Maintain attendance records.
- Handle correspondence.
- Provide a year-end report to the incoming Secretary.

Treasurer

- Manage all PTO funds.
- o Provide financial reports at each meeting.
- Sign checks and maintain accurate financial records.
- o File required tax forms by the end of the fiscal year.
- o Provide a year-end financial report to the incoming Treasurer.
- o In the Treasurer's absence, Co-Presidents may sign checks.
